For spring semester 2024, about 25% of our students have enrolled in at least one dual enrollment class so far with West Hills College. Dual enrollment classes offer our students many advantages, including: exploring new topics not offered in our regular curriculum, participating in sportsthemed classes like soccer and archery, exploring Career & Technical Education (CTE) classes, and getting a head start on building up their college credits while still earning credits for high school graduation. To support our high school students who choose to enroll in dual enrollment classes while at Lemoore Online, the counselor hosts the "College Bound" Club two times a month. This club offers a support network for our students wherein they can meet, study with, and gain support from other dual-enrolled students.
